Management

We hold weekly meetings to exchange ideas and review our methods. Communication is our strength and all our foremen have mobile phones to communicate with engineers and supervisors. We're constantly reviewing our staff's technology needs, so when a decision needs to be made on the spot, it is done quickly and efficiently.

Material usage is recorded in a logbook at our Silverdale yard and tracked by order number. The foreman records on-site information like machine hours, concrete quantities and drill metres daily. The worksheet, logbook and supervisor's diary are diligently cross-referenced and checked before invoicing.

Methods

Prior to a job, we build strong relationships with councils, engineers, material suppliers and subcontractors, meaning your project runs smoothly and efficiently.

On commencement of each job, a supervisor ensures that issues like road signs, traffic control and neighbourly relations are handled correctly.

We only use quality-assured materials, like Atlas concrete and Ramsey Roundwood poles and we ensure quality on site by using engineers and council verification.

Experienced supervisors oversee every job, in direct consultation with the business principals, Alastair and Sam Cumming.



WHAT EQUIPMENT DO WE HAVE?

From excavators to pile drivers, we've got the gear to get the job done.

We have a wide range of light and heavy machinery to beat anything your project can throw at us.

We have several excavators including:

- 1 x 20 tonne excavator
- 3 x 12 tonne excavators
- 2 x 7 tonne excavators
- 1 x 5 tonne excavator

We also have:

- 2 x 6 Wheel tip trucks
- 2 x 4-wheel tip trucks
- Hydraulic piling machines with 250kg, 350kg, 750kg and 1000kg hammer weights
- Hydraulic drill rigs to suit excavators, with maximum embedment depths of 18m at 1.2m diameter
- 4-wheel-drive tractor piling rigs
